

# Installation instruction for Windows version of Q7Basic

## Qt SDK installation

With the latest version of the Qt SDK, its installation default has changed and important packages for Q7Basic are not automatically selected anymore. So it is important that you change the default behavior of the Qt SDK installation, otherwise gcc/mingw compilation will not work. Additionally, you must install the separate version of Qt for VS 2008 [it is called libraries 4.8.0 for Windows (VS 2008)].

The Qt SDK includes more tools you need to build desktop applications. So you may not install the packages for embedded and mobile applications. All you need to do is to change the packages to the right one.

## In the Qt SDK installer you will need to select

- mingw compiler
- Qt for mingw

## You must NOT select in the Qt SDK installer

- Qt for Visual VS 2008 (if you need it, you have to install it separately – see the other download link on [www.q7basic.org](http://www.q7basic.org))
